Please read the following carefully, before preparing your presentation.

In June 2010, Apple released the iPhone 4. Soon afterwards, users discovered a problem with the phone. When the phone was being held a certain way, there would be a massive drop in the signal strength, and sometimes calls would be cut off. This was thought to be an issue with the antennas on the phone and the whole episode became known as "Antennagate".

For this assignment, I want you to assume that you are one of the engineers working at Apple in 2010. You have been assigned to investigate what is going on with the iPhone 4. You have done a lot of tests on the phone, and finally you have found the root cause of the problem. Now, Apple's senior management and in particular its CEO, Steve Jobs, wants to know what the problem is. The iPhone is a really important product for Apple. As a result, Apple is under a lot of pressure to inform its customers and the media as to what is really going on with these phones.

Prepare a PowerPoint presentation that you would present to Apple's senior management on the antenna problems with the iPhone 4 and your recommendations on how it could be fixed. Keep your presentation to no more than 10 slides. Steve Jobs hates long, drawn-out presentations so you need to keep your presentation short and to the point. Just focus on describing what the problem is and your recommendations on how to fix it.

There are two deliverables you need to prepare for this assignment (you need to submit BOTH BY FRIDAY, May 31st, 2024 before your assignment can be considered complete; otherwise you will get ZERO points from this assignment):

 Presentation (prepared in PowerPoint and saved as PDF) - Once you have completed preparing your presentation in PowerPoint, please save it as a PDF file with the following format:
