Covey (you can download a PDF copy at <https://depo.erciyes.edu.tr/index.php/s/d78Pgpr8EjtR9DX> with the password mem2132024* and navigating to the **class materials** subfolder). Once you read it, prepare the deliverables as detailed below.

There are two deliverables you need to prepare for this assignment (**you need to submit BOTH BY FRIDAY, January 3rd, 2025 17:00 before your assignment can be considered complete; otherwise you will get ZERO points from this assignment**):

1. **Presentation (maximum 10 slides, prepared in PowerPoint and saved as PDF)** - Once you have completed preparing your presentation in PowerPoint, please save it as a PDF file with the following format:
