Please read the following carefully, before preparing your presentation.

On October 21st, 2016 a distributed denial of service attack on an internet service provider named Dyn caused disruptions to large portions of the Internet. This attack was unique in the sense that it was believed to have been carried out by a large number of internet-connected devices such as IP cameras, baby monitors and printers, all of which implement Internet of Things (IOT) functionality to some degree.

Imagine that you are managing the public relations office at Dyn. People (including the media) are calling you, wanting to find out what is going on. Prepare a PowerPoint presentation (no more than 15 slides) to brief the media on what caused the attack, and what your company is doing about it.

You may wish to look at this article to get a general idea of the topic: <u>https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/2016_Dyn_cyberattack</u>. However, you are expected to do more research on your own, and come up with more material.

There are two deliverables you need to prepare for this assignment (*you need to submit BOTH BY Friday, 13.06.2025 before your assignment can be considered complete; otherwise you will get ZERO points from this assignment):*

1. **Presentation (prepared in PowerPoint and saved as PDF)** - Once you have completed preparing your presentation in PowerPoint, please save it as a PDF file with the following format:

 presentation, as it will not get you any credit. Use your OWN words!!</u>
- 2. If you put any material in your slides, I will assume that you understand it. So, <u>PLEASE only include</u> <u>material in your presentation that you truly understand</u>.
- **3.** Please DO NOT use internet-based translation services like Google Translate. They will not give you meaningful translations in a lot of cases, and may even make your presentation more difficult to understand.
- 4. <u>Before preparing your presentation, first put yourself in the position of your audience. Think about the following points. What would you want to hear from the presentation? What kinds of questions would you ask? Then prepare a presentation to address those points.</u>
