Read the section titled “Habit 2: Begin with the End in Mind” from the book “The Seven Habits of Highly Effective People” by Stephen P. Covey (you can download a PDF copy at [with the password mem2132024*](#) and navigating to the **class materials** subfolder). Once you read it, prepare the deliverables mentioned below, focusing on the following points (***please note: be prepared to talk in detail about these points***):

1. What is Habit 2 all about?
2. What does the author mean when he says “All things are created twice”?
3. According to the author, what is the difference between leadership and management?
4. Think back to your own life. Have you ever applied the principles that this chapter talks about? If not, how do you think you could?

There are two deliverables you need to prepare for this assignment (***you need to complete BOTH by 25.12.2025 before your assignment can be considered complete; otherwise you will get ZERO points from this assignment***):

1. **PowerPoint Presentation** - Once you have completed preparing your presentation in PowerPoint, take a printout and submit it to the instructor on the day of your presentation.
2. **Group Spoken Presentation (AS A GROUP, IN PERSON, IN CLASS ON 25.12.2025)** – The presentation should be no more than 15 minutes.

PLEASE NOTE: DO NOT use internet-based translation services like Google Translate. They will not give you meaningful translations in a lot of cases, and may even make your presentation more difficult to understand. Use of such platforms qualifies as plagiarism and you will receive ZERO points from this assignment if you do use them.
